**Associate Director of The Cancer Institute of New Jersey Tapped for Prominent Post**  
*Dr. Bruce G. Haffty to Serve as President-Elect of American Board of Radiology*

**New Brunswick, N.J., March 13, 2008** – The associate director of The Cancer Institute of New Jersey (CINJ), Bruce G. Haffty, M.D., who is a professor and chair of the Department of Radiology Oncology at UMDNJ-Robert Wood Johnson Medical School, has been named president-elect of the American Board of Radiology (ABR).

Dr. Haffty, who also is the chief of Radiation Oncology at CINJ – a Center of Excellence of UMDNJ-Robert Wood Johnson Medical School – will begin his two-year term in June. It will be followed by a two-year term as president of the organization, which is one of the nation's larger specialty boards charged with certification oversight and certification maintenance for medical specialties. ABR boasts more than 30,000 active physician-certified specialists in the areas of diagnostic radiology, radiation oncology and radiological physics. N. Reed Dunnick, M.D., chairman of the Department of Radiology at the University of Michigan, current president-elect of the ABR will assume his two-year term as president in June.

Haffty, who is internationally recognized for his clinical expertise in breast cancer and his clinical and translational research in radiation oncology, was certified in radiation oncology by the ABR in 1988 after completing his residency at Yale University. He has served in several volunteer capacities for the ABR through the years, having been elected to the Board of Trustees in 2005. He also has served as assistant executive director of the ABR in charge of the primary certification exam in Radiation Oncology, vice chair of the Maintenance of Certification Committee, and chair of the Breast Category Examination in Radiation Oncology.

Along with being the author of more than 200 articles, editorials and reviews, Haffty has edited and authored numerous books and book chapters, and is a member of the editorial board of several medical journals, which includes his associate editor position of the Journal of Clinical Oncology.
