Course Overview

The CINJ Clinical Research Essentials Class is intended to provide an overview of the required aspects of study preparation and conduct. Participants will gain knowledge of the components of a study protocol, learn how to prepare for study activation, ensure informed consent, and to recognize and report adverse events. They will also learn about FDA requirements for record keeping, study drug handling and other essential documentation. An overview of the Oncore™ clinical trials data base will be available.
