Author and Journalist to Speak at CINJ

- WHO:** Suzanne Gordon, freelance journalist and author, will join Regina Cunningham, Ph.D., RN, AOCN, Chief Nursing Officer at The Cancer Institute of New Jersey (CINJ) and the Institute's nursing staff for their annual Nurse Day celebration.

Her most recent book, *Nursing Against the Odds: How Health Care Cost Cutting, Media Stereotypes, and Medical Hubris Undermine Nurses and Patient Care* was published in spring 2005.
