**RAMBLEWOOD COUNTRY CLUB HOSTS
JON RUNYAN \$5,000,000 HOLE IN ONE SHOOT OUT**

*Proceeds to Benefit the Prostate Cancer Program
at The Cancer Institute of New Jersey*

MOUNT LAUREL, NJ– Help fight prostate cancer at Ramblewood Country Club on Sunday, April 10, 2005 from 10:00 am to 4:30 pm during the **Dietz and Watson/Jon Runyan \$5,000,000 Hole In One Shoot Out** to benefit The Cancer Institute of New Jersey (www.cinj.org). Qualify, and be one of five finalists who will each take a shot at \$1,000,000.

From 10:00 am to 4:30 pm, contestants will qualify through a closest to the pin contest on the ninth hole of the Red course. The cost to take a qualifying shot is \$20 per attempt, and you can take as many as you want but only the closest shot will count. At 4:30 pm sharp the last qualifying shot can be taken. The five people with shots closest to the pin will proceed to the first hole on the Blue course where the distance for men will measure 165 yards and for women 150 yards; each will take their shot at a \$1,000,000 hole in one.

If no one gets a hole in one, the person who is closest to the pin on one Blue will receive a one-year membership to Ramblewood, a \$1,900 value. The other four finalists will each receive a gift certificate for a foursome, a \$260 value. The proceeds of the shoot out will benefit the prostate cancer program at The Cancer Institute of New Jersey.
