



## CANCER RESEARCH EXPERIENCE [CARE] SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarship recipients will be full time or part-time incoming undergraduate or graduate students selected based on academic merit as determined by RUYES Program Director, financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid (Rutgers), and University rules. Qualified students must complete the appropriate University requirements each year to determine financial need. Students should have a minimum SAT score of 1150 and/or a GPA of 3.2.
- Recipients should be participants of the RUYES at Rutgers Cancer Institute of New Jersey.
- Two to three recipients will be selected each year to receive this scholarship [~\$2,500.00 each].
  Provided that the recipients maintain eligibility, awards may be renewed at the discretion of the Program Director.
  - Applicants must be:
  - ❖ Participant of RUYES at Rutgers Cancer Institute of New Jersey
  - ❖ Full time or part-time incoming undergraduate or graduate students
  - ❖ Must be interested in pursuing a STEM major
  - Engaged in undergraduate or graduate study at Rutgers
  - ❖ In good academic standing with an overall G.P.A. of 3.2 or equivalent
