

## To be eligible to apply for the RUYES program a student must be:

- 1. A rising high school junior/senior or rising freshman/sophomore undergraduate
- 2. From one of the following underrepresented backgrounds:
  - African American
  - Hispanic/Latino
  - Native American
  - Alaska Native
  - Pacific Islander
  - A first generation college student
  - From a lower socioeconomic background
- 3. A citizen or permanent resident (green-card holder) of the United States
- 4. Willing to commit to two full years of participation in the program
- 5. Highly motivated and academically able to pursue a career in biomedical/cancer science

## How to Apply (Click here to apply)

Applications will be accepted through March 31<sup>st</sup> for Summer 2021. To complete your application, you will be asked to include:

1. Full student contact information (name, email, phone number, name of school district) and personal demographics. High school students will need consent of a parent/guardian.

You should also be prepared to upload the following documents:

2. A copy of your transcripts. An unofficial transcript will be accepted for the application process; upon acceptance please prepare to have your school send your official transcripts.

3. A two-page essay. Please answer the following questions in essay form. Your submission must be typed, double-spaced, and no more than two pages in length. Be sure to put your name on each page of your response to the essay questions.

- Discuss your long-term career and/or educational goals.
- Describe your favorite learning experience. (This does not have to be limited to a school experience.)
- Why do you believe this research opportunity is a good fit for you?
- What do you plan on gaining from this research experience?

4. Two letters of recommendation, one of which is from a teacher or college faculty member. If your reference prefers to send the letter separately, attach a PDF of your request to your application and have them email the letter to <u>RUYES@cinj.rutgers.edu</u>.
