The *Rutgers Youth Enjoy Science (RUYES)* program seeks to encourage youth interested in the biomedical sciences to pursue cancer research and healthcare careers. *Funded by the National Institutes of Health/National Cancer Institute grant 2R25CA247785.*

WHAT TO EXPECT?

Students will have the opportunity to:

- Engage in basic, clinical, or population-based cancer research for 9-10 weeks during two consecutive summers. (2025 and 2026)
- Receive professional development and training in Topics of Cancer Biology, Laboratory Skills, and Career Development.
- Present their research findings at an Annual Research Symposium.
- Receive compensation for time.

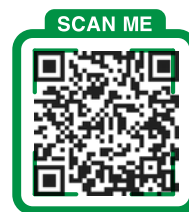
